## Storm's Warnings & Tips



Taking your boat out to the lake? Hauling your camper for a weekend in the wilderness? Before you hitch up and head out this summer, keep these safety tips in mind.

1. Check the tire pressure, lug nuts and bolts on the vehicle and trailer

2. Be sure the hitch, coupler, and draw bar are connected, secured and adjusted as needed
3. Make sure the wiring is properly connected and all lights and signals are working
4. Make sure the brakes

- on the vehicle and trailer are working
5. Check the load distribution to make sure the vehicle and trailer are balanced
6. Be sure you have good visibility with all mirrors
